### **Notice to Exhibitors**

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of AAC rules and regulations including, but not limited to, the following:

This event will be held in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Agility Association of Canada (AAC). The obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the *AAC Official Rules and Regulations* and shall conform to AAC specifications.

All breeds and mixed breeds eighteen months of age and older (no exceptions) are eligible to compete. Blind, lame, or aggressive dogs are ineligible as are bitches in season, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance (judge's discretion).

**All dogs must have an AAC Registration Number before their entries will be accepted in an AAC sanctioned trial. The registration form is available at [www.aac.ca](http://www.aac.ca), General Information, Official Forms. Dogs with numbers pending will not be eligible to compete.**

No toys, food, or other training devices shall be allowed on the course.

All dogs must be **under control** (i.e. penned, crated, or leashed) when not in the ring. Please take responsibility for your dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behaviour may be asked by the Trial Committee to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds for entries if the dog or handler is *dismissed* from the competition for any reason.

All exhibitors entering this trial are required to work as a volunteer. A workers volunteer schedule will be posted on Saturday and Sunday mornings. Please check the volunteer sheet to see what positions you have been assigned for each day and if there are any conflicts with it and your running order please let the Trial Chair know.

### **ENTRIES**

- Jump2Q Dog Agility reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- Anyone not in good standing with AAC will not be allowed to enter the trial.
- Cheques in CDN funds only are made payable to Brigitte Eisengruber and dated no later than the closing date.
- Refunds will not be given for cancellations after the closing date except for bitches in season or injury to a dog (veterinarian certificate required), or handler, which physically prevents them from competing. Refunds requested for any other reason will be handled on a case-by-case basis and will be at the sole discretion of Jump2Q Dog Agility.
- By AAC rules, entries are not valid until payment of entry fees has been received or confirmed.

## AAC CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

- Starters: Open to dogs that have not earned a Starters title.
- Advanced: Open to dogs that have not earned an Advanced title.
- Masters: Open to dogs that have earned an Advanced title.
- Regular: Dogs will jump standard heights and course times as set by AAC rules.
- Specials: Open to all dogs. Course times and jump heights will be as per AAC rules. Please check with the AAC for the rule change that permits a “one time” move between Specials and Regular divisions. Dogs may move from the Specials division to the Veterans division.
- Veterans: For dogs 7 years of age or older in the case of dogs who have been competing in Regular classes; for dogs 5 years of age or older who have been competing in the Specials division for a minimum of one year. Once a dog has entered an official trial in the Veterans division, they may no longer compete in the Regular or Specials divisions. Course times and jump heights will be as per AAC rules.

## PRIZES

- All classes will receive flat ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup>.

## DIRECTIONS TO RAVENWOOD PARK

### FROM HALIFAX

HWY #101  
Take Exit #17 East  
Turn left onto Bishop Mountain Road  
Bishop Mountain Road becomes Maple Street  
Turn left onto Balsler Drive  
Ravenwood Park is at the end of Balsler Drive

### FROM DIGBY

HWY#101  
Take Exit 17 West  
Turn right onto Marshall Road  
Turn left onto Main Street  
Turn left onto Maple Street  
Turn right onto Balsler Drive  
Ravenwood Park is at the end of Balsler Drive

## DIRECTIONS TO SHOOTING STAR STABLES:

### **From Highway 101:**

Take exit **18** on **HWY 101**- Middleton, at the stop sign turn left to Middleton. Pass by a Jeep dealership on the left and keep going about 1.5 km to the next stop sign.

- Turn left (Hwy 1) to Middleton. You will pass by the Mid Valley Motel. In Middleton on your right hand side is a Needs convenient store. Turn right onto Hwy # 10, over the Bridge, follow the Hwy. It makes a turn to the left after the Bridge and then stay on this road for about 1,8km (from the convenient store)

- On the left hand side there is a road called "Rogers Road". Take a left there and it will bring you in a subdivision. Stay on this road till what looks like the end of the road, but Rogers road will turn to the right. Go straight ahead and the road will turn into a dirt road. You can see the horse fences. Follow the dirt road along the horse fences and it will end up at the horse barn. Just park and go to the big red building, which is the indoor arena.

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If you are coming from Hwy # 10: There is a Fast Fuel gas station on your left hand side. Pass by and stay on Hwy # 10 till the Hwy starts to turn left after about 2km. Watch out for Rogers Road on your right. Turn onto Rogers Road and follow the instructions above.

## AAC Registration Agreement

**Note: This agreement must be signed before your dog can participate in this event.**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the organizing committee shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, the holding of this event and the opportunity to have the dog participate or be judged, I (we) agree to hold the organising committee, the organisation which it represents, including its members, officers and directors, owners of premises upon which the event is held and their employees, harmless from any claim for loss of injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person of thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence or any other person, or any other cause or causes.
